

SCHEDULING INFORMATION
AREA C 5A & 6A MARCHING CONTEST
2021

The schedule for the Area C Marching Contest will be determined as follows:

Area C 5A consists of Regions 3, 4, 20, & 21. Area C 6A consists of Regions 2, 3, 4, 21, 24, & 25. 5A Region marching contests are currently scheduled to be completed on or before October 16; 6A Region contests are currently scheduled to be completed on or before October 20.

The drawing for **performance order** was held on September 15 and is posted on the Region 3 website. Following the completion of the Region contests on October 16 or 20, the schedule(s) will be revised based on the bands from all regions that will advance to Area. **THE FINAL “OFFICIAL” SCHEDULES WILL BE POSTED ON THE REGION 3 WEBSITE NO LATER THAN 4 p.m., MONDAY, OCTOBER 18 FOR 5A; THURSDAY, OCTOBER 21 FOR 6A.** Starting time will be determined by the number of bands attending in each conference.

YOU WILL BE ASKED TO EMAIL SOME INFORMATION TO BONNIE BARTLETT NO LATER THAN 4 P.M., MONDAY, OCTOBER 18 (5A) OR MONDAY, OCTOBER 25 (6A). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR EMAIL A DAY OR TWO PRIOR TO YOUR REGION CONTEST!

AREA C MARCHING CONTEST SCHEDULING GUIDELINES

(Approved by the Area C Marching Executive Committee, November 2004)

The Area C Marching Contest schedule will be done by random draw for time slots. Special scheduling requests will not be accommodated, with the following exception.

Bands that have over 90 miles to the contest site will not be scheduled for a performance time earlier than 1 p.m. If, during the random draw, a band meeting this criteria is drawn, that band will be assigned the 1 p.m. time slot (or the time nearest to 1 p.m. depending on break times, etc.) Any subsequent bands meeting the distance criteria drawn before the 1 p.m. time slot will be assigned the next available time after 1 p.m.
